2009 Gove Peninsula Float Parade Nitty Gritty

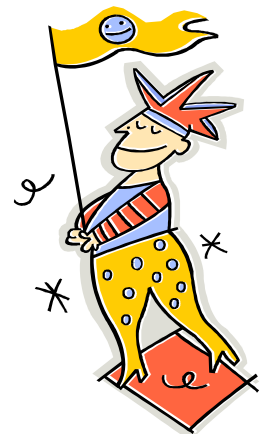
1. Your entry form is to be received by the closing date of 19th June 2009. Please contact Helen Italiano (8987 2683) if you have any challenges meeting this time.
2. Register in the lower Nhulunbuy High School carpark opposite the school entrance 9am onwards. Vehicles to be assembled in lower Nhulunbuy High School carpark by 9.30am, participants associated with floats to assemble by 9.45am to allow the parade to start at 10am.
3. Vehicles not in the parade are instructed to be kept out of the assembly area in the lower Nhulunbuy High School carpark. Check with the marshal at the Thunderman Road/Matthew Flinders Way corner before bringing any vehicles into the lower Nhulunbuy High School carpark.
4. All vehicles to be appropriately registered and roadworthy. Drivers must carry a license for that type of vehicle used with them on that day.
5. Giveaways to be distributed by participants walking along side the float and not thrown from the float into the crowd.
6. You will be given a float number. This will be the number of your position in the parade. It is to identify you for the commentators and judges. Please place this number in a prominent place on the driver's side of vehicle so it can be easily seen from the front.
7. Please follow the instructions of the marshals along the parade route.
8. Once you have started in the parade keep your float at least 25-30 metres (one and half bus lengths) back from the float in front of you.
9. Keep your floats going slowly as possible. Do NOT speed up.
10. The official part of the parade finishes in Bottlebrush Avenue at Hindle Oval in front of the cat shed.
11. Those who do not wish to display their cars are to deliver their passengers along Bottlebrush Avenue on the left hand side facing the Cat Shed leaving the area.
12. All participants are to dismount or dismiss from the LEFT hand side of their float on to the grass/gravel/pavement. Parents are to collect their children from the grassed area at Hindle Oval. Dismount your participants as quickly and safely as possible.
